



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of access restrictions and parking controls in a Pedestrian Zone in Maidstone High street in the County of Kent, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at the sites on the said roads marked with a green cross of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") on the attached plan numbered GT50/060/003 -1 conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0003-2, save that references to the time of the day may be varied or omitted and days of the week may be added ; and
2. authorises the erection at the sites on the said roads marked with a purple cross of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") on the said plan conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0003-3, save that references to the time of the day may be varied or omitted and days of the week may be added ; and
3. directs that directs that the authorised sign B shall be used with a bay conforming as to size with the road marking shown in diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 6 to The Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I, SI 2002 No. 3113)("the 2002 Regulations") but with no legend and delineated with surfacing or paving contrasting in colour or appearance with the surrounding carriage way; and



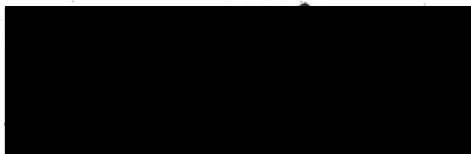
4. directs, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B shall only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 618.3 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

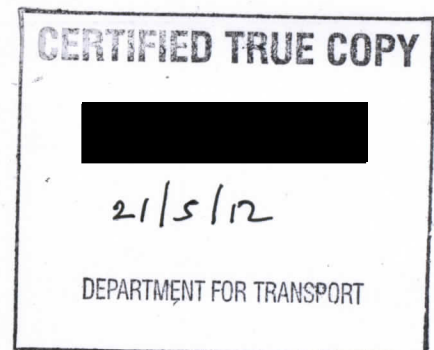
The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign B in the same manner as they apply to the road marking to diagram 661A in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

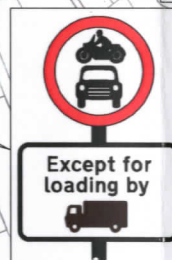
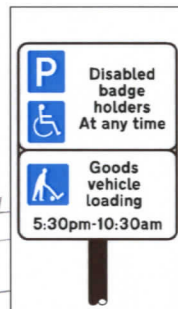
