**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of mobile phone park and pay zones on roads for which the London Borough of Southwark is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/094/0001-1, save that:
 - (a) the reference to the time limit, the time of day or the day of the week may be varied or omitted; and
 - (b) the legend "Permit holders" may be omitted, in which case the permit parking identification patch shall also be omitted; and
 - (c) the permit parking identification patch may be varied; and
 - (d) the legend "or" above the legend "Pay by phone" may be omitted; and
 - (e) the telephone number and location code may be varied; and
 - (f) an arrow may be added below the reference to the time of day; and
 - (g) the arrow below the legend "Pay at machine" may be replaced by the legend "opposite"; and
 - (h) the direction of an arrow may be varied with the arrow pointing horizontally to the left or to the right; and

- (i) the legend "Pay at machine" may be replaced by the legend "Pay here at machine" (on two lines); and
2. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), the authorised sign may be used with the road marking shown in diagram 1028.4 when no legend appears in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
3. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25 of the 2002 Directions, the authorised sign may be used with the road marking shown in diagram 1032 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations; and
4. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and
5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

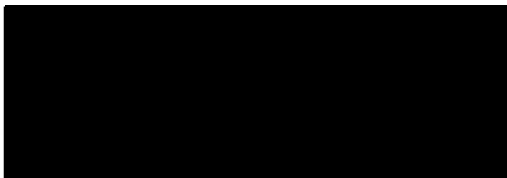

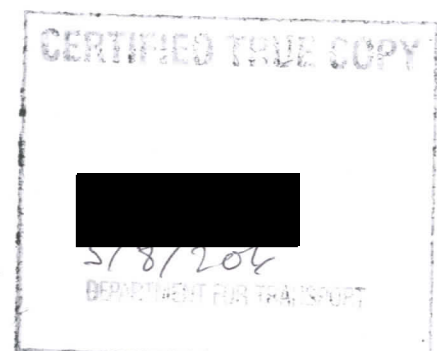
