

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the conditions of use of bus lanes at various locations on Wavertree Road, Picton Road, High Street, Rice Lane, County Road, East Prescot Road, Prescot Road and Kensington in Sheffield, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at the sites marked SF1 in the attached set of plans numbered GT50/69/0002-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at A on the attached drawing numbered GT50/69/0002-2; and
- authorises the erection at the sites marked SF2 in the said set of plans of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at B on the said drawing; and
- authorises the erection at the sites marked SF4 in the said set of plans of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at C on the said drawing; and
- authorises the erection at the sites marked SF5 in the said set of plans of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at D on the said drawing; and





- 5. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 18(3) of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), the authorised signs A and C may be used with the road markings shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 18(3) of the 2002 Directions, the authorised signs B and D may be used with the road markings shown in diagrams 1048 and 1049 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations; and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A, B, C and D may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 8. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A, B, C and D at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A, B, C and D and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A and C in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 958 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.



## GT50/69/0002

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs B and D in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 959 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.
