

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II to SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 21 of the 2002 Directions, a sign to diagram 616 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I to SI 2002/3113, "The 2002 Regulations") may be used in conjunction with a plate to diagram 954.3 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations, within the vicinity of the sites marked with a green cross on the attached plan numbered GT50/24/0012-1; and
- directs that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the preceding paragraph, this special direction shall be retained for no longer than 18 months from this date.
