

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of a Restricted Zone on the Promenade, Blackpool, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked with a green cross on the attached plan numbered GT50/8/0001-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 663.2, save that the legend on the lower panel shall read "At any time except in signed bays"; and
- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site marked with an orange cross on the said plan of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 664.1; and
- authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said plan of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 637.4; and
- directs that the road markings shown in diagrams 1017, 1018.1, 1028.3. 1028.4 and 1032 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") need not be used with the authorised signs A, B and C; and



- directs, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A, B and C may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised signs A, B and C at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A, B and C and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 663 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 664 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign C in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 637 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
