



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of parking places partially and wholly on the footway on roads for which the London Borough of Newham is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown as "Type 'S" on the attached set of drawings numbered GT50/091/0002-1, save that the times of the day, days of the week and permit holder identification code may be varied or omitted as appropriate; and
- 2. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown as "Type 'K'" on the said set of drawings, save that the times of the day, days of the week and permit holder identification code may be varied or omitted as appropriate; and
- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25(1) of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113) the authorised signs A and B shall only be erected in conjunction with the road marking to diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and

- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and
- 5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.


