



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of warning of routes unsuitable for heavy goods vehicles on roads in the London Borough of Bromley, hereby:-

- authorises the erection on roads in London Borough of Bromley of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the drawing numbered NP 820.2; and
- authorises the erection on roads in London Borough of Bromley of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the drawing numbered NP 820.3; and
- 3. directs that, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A and B on the said roads shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.




The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) shall apply to the authorised signs A and B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 820 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
