

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 65 SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

- 1. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Directions 24(3) and 24(4) of the 2002 Directions, the road marking shown in diagram 1018.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) need not be used in conjunction with signs to diagram 618.3 and to diagram 637.2 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations in Newburgh Street, Ganton Street, Marshall Street and Foubert's Place in the City of Westminster as indicated on the attached plan numbered GT50/024/0008-1; and
- 2. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 8(4)(b)(ii) of the 2002 Directions the sign to diagram 618.3 need only be placed on one side of the road at Ganton Street as shown on the said plan.
