

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of giving additional warning to road users to reduce speed on the northbound approach to the Stoke Hammond Roundabout on the A4146 Stoke Hammond bypass in Buckinghamshire, hereby:-

- authorises the placing within the vicinity of the site highlighted in yellow on the attached plan numbered GT50/017/0003-1 of a traffic sign consisting of road markings (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised markings") conforming as to size, colour and character with those shown in Figure 11-1 in Chapter 5 of the Traffic Signs Manual and to spacing with Table 11-1 in the said Manual; and
- 2. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised markings within the vicinity of the site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised markings and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect; and





The provisions of Regulations 11, 12, 31 and 32 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) shall apply to the authorised markings in the same manner as they apply to the marking to diagram 1017 in Schedule 6 to those Regulations.
