

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 64
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the provision of electric car charging points at Motorway Service Areas, hereby:-


1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on motorways for which the Highways Agency is the traffic authority of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred as the "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/056/0004-1 save that the sign may be varied in a similar manner to sign 2919.1 in Schedule 7 to The Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") provided that the symbol for electric vehicle charging point shall always be adjacent to the spoon and fork symbol or the next symbol on the line below, and

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 2919.1 in Schedule 7 to those Regulations.

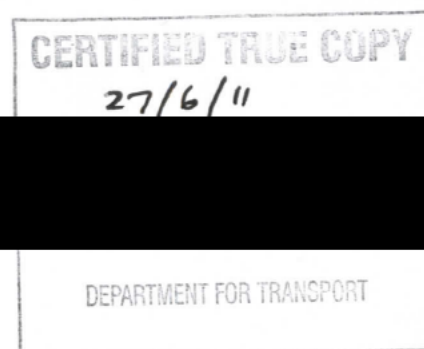
