ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 65


SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, “the 2002 Directions”), hereby:-


1. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 21 of the 2002 Directions, a sign to diagram 616 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) may be used in conjunction with a plate to diagram 954.4 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations, within 5 metres of the sites marked on the attached plan numbered GT50/015/0007-1.



Notes

- Mounting height shall be a minimum of 2500mm in pedestrian/cycle areas
- No sign or part of sign shall be less than 450mm from highway
- Sign 616 to be illuminated using direct external lighting
- Sign 616 + 954.4 to have reflective material class RA2 (12899 -1:2007)
