


ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 65 SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

- 1. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 18(1) of the 2002 Directions, a sign comprising of a road marking to diagram 1065 in Schedule 6 to the to the Traffic Sign Regulations 2002 (Part of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") need not be used in conjunction with a sign to diagram 670 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations, within 5 metres of the sites marked with a green or blue circle on the attached plan numbered GT50/035/0019-1; and
- directs that notwithstanding Direction 11(2) of the 2002 Directions, a sign to diagram 670 in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations need not be placed at regular intervals on roads shown on the said plan between the points marked A and B.
