**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 65
SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

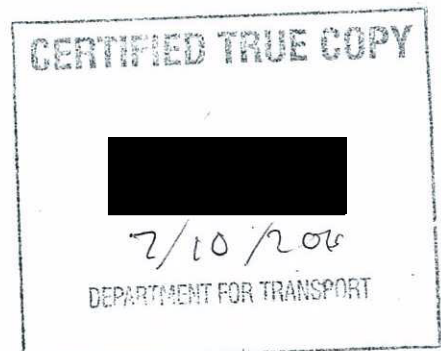
1. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Directions 24(3), 24(4)(a)(i) of the 2002 Directions, the road markings to diagrams 1017, 1018.1 and 1019 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) need not be used in conjunction with signs to diagrams 618.3, 637.2 and 618.4 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations on Bath Passage in the Royal Borough of Kingston-upon-Thames indicated by grey shading on the attached plan numbered GT50/155/0003-1.
