

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of facilitating military repatriations at Brize Norton Airbase in Oxfordshire, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked with a black cross on the attached set of plans numbered GT50/120/0006-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at A on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0006-2; and
- directs that the authorised plate may only be used in conjunction with a sign to diagram 617 or 619 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2001/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
- directs that the authorised plate may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 4. directs that without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plate at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.




The provisions of Regulations 12 and 20 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate to diagram 878 in Schedule 4 to those Regulations.


