




ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the presence of time over distance safety cameras at appropriate sites on roads for which Essex County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at the said sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 878.1; and
- directs that the authorised sign may be placed only in an area or along a route where enforcement cameras are from time to time in use; and
- 3. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.





The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 878 in Schedule 4 to those Regulations.
