ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 65

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

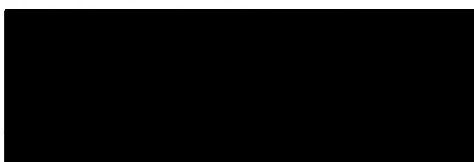
The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

1. directs that, at appropriate locations within the black boundary line shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/007-2 signs to diagrams 650.1 and 660.4 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") may be used in conjunction with each other; and
2. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 24(1) of the 2002 Directions, signs to diagrams 650.1 and 660.4 in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations, when used in conjunction with each other shall be used with (i) the road marking to diagram 1028.3 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations save that the legend "DISABLED" shall be omitted; and (ii) the road marking to diagram 1017 in Schedule 6 to the said Regulations on the said roads.

This authorisation replaces the earlier one dated 10 August 2011 under reference GT50/006/004 which is hereby revoked.

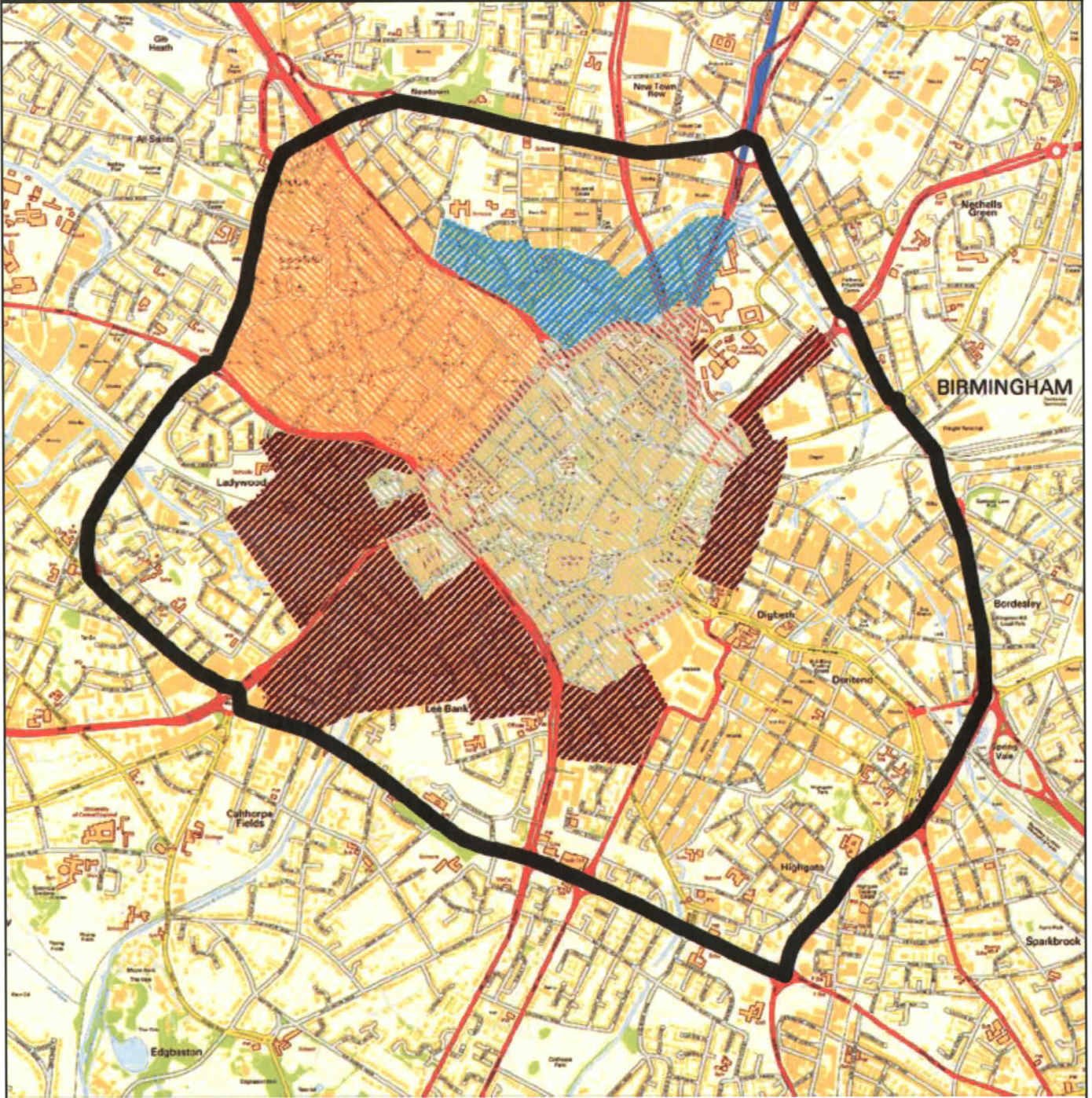


