**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of a delay caused by a temporary obstruction on roads for which Kent County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced “Authorised Sign” on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0010-1; and
2. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month’s notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect; and
3. directs that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the preceding paragraph, the authorised sign shall be retained for no longer than 9 months from the date of this authorisation.



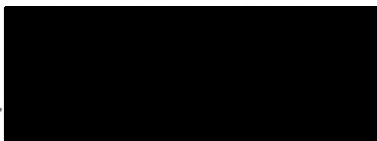
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The provisions of Regulation 12, 18 and 19 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 7010.1 in Schedule 12 to those Regulations.

This authorisation replaces the one referenced GT50/60/002, dated 23 December 2010.
