





ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the temporary suspension of parking places in the City of London, hereby:-

- authorises the erection on roads for which the Corporation of London is traffic authority of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/027/0007-1 save that:
- (a) information regarding the time of day, date or dates, (with the year omitted) and location of the suspended parking place or places shall be shown on the front of the authorised sign; and
- (b) information regarding the type of parking place, the reason for the parking suspension, or an identifying reference may be shown on the authorised sign; and
- directs that the authorised sign may not be erected at the same location for longer than six months; and





The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of The Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002 No. 3113) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 636 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
