

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 65

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling her in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

- directs that, at the locations shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/055/0011-1, signs to diagrams 616 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") may be used in conjunction with plates to diagram 954.3 in Schedule 5 to the said Regulations; and
- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25(1) of the 2002 Directions, the road marking to diagram 1048.4 in Schedule 6 to the 2002 Regulations may be placed without the sign to diagram 953 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations on the said roads; and
- directs that the traffic signs and road markings described in paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be retained no longer than 18 months from the date of this Special Direction.
