



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of badgers on the highway over a distance of half a mile at Three Locks in the vicinity of Leighton Buzzard in Buckinghamshire, hereby:-


1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked with a red cross on the attached plan numbered GT50/017/0006-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at A on the attached drawing numbered GT50/017/0006-2 and
2. directs that the authorised plate shall only be used with the sign to diagram 562 in Schedule 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
3. directs that the provisions of Direction 20 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions") shall not apply to the sign to diagram 562 of the 2002 Regulations when used with the authorised plate; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plate at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



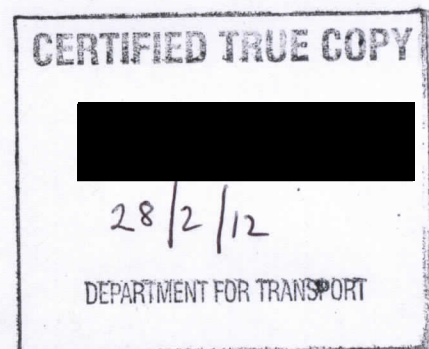
The provisions of Regulations 12 and 20 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate shown in diagram 563 when used in conjunction with the sign to diagram 562 in Schedule 1 to those Regulations.

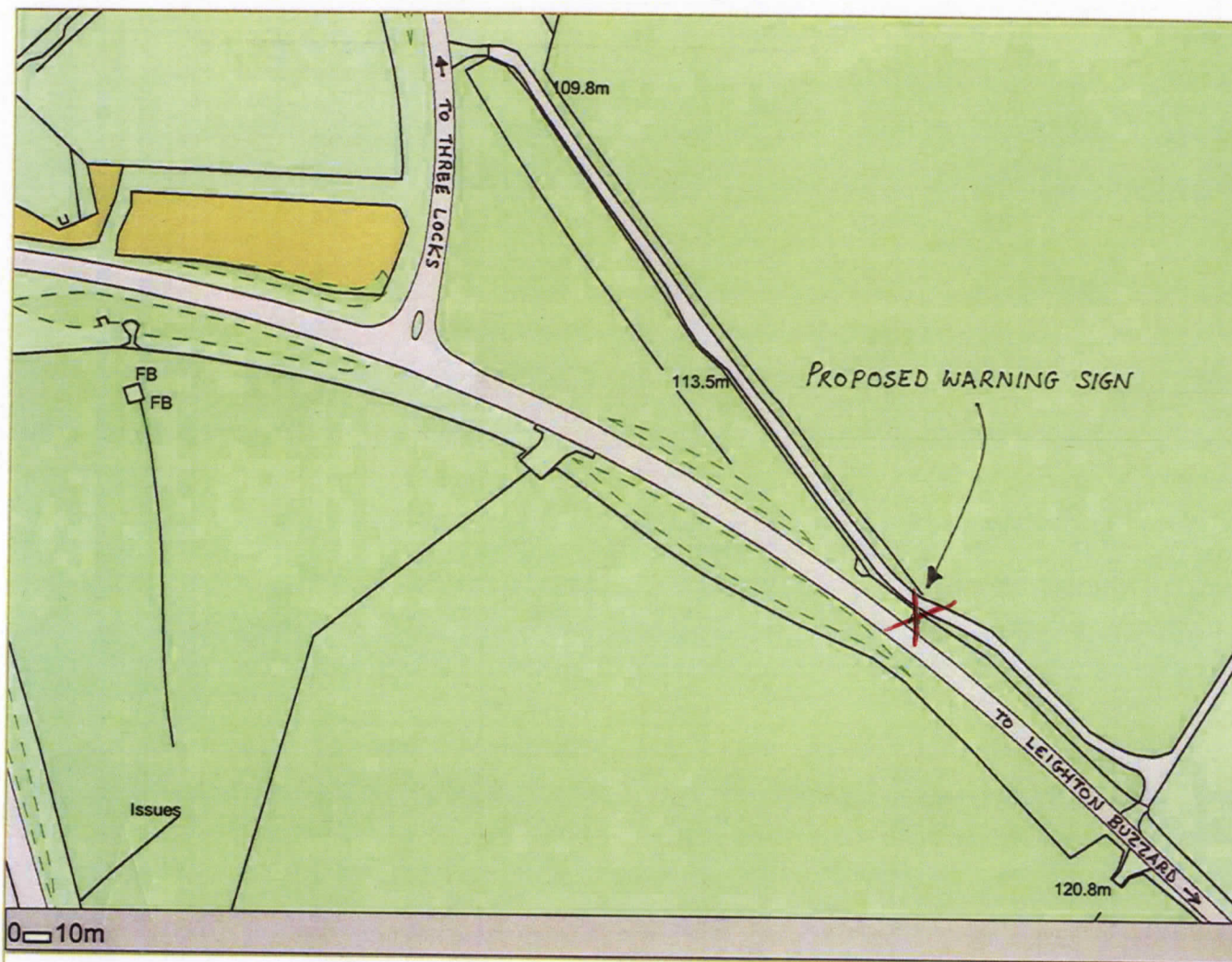
