

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of indicating parking places for disabled persons on roads for which Southampton City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- authorises the placing at the locations shown in the attached set of plans numbered GT50/150/0014-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking") conforming as to size, colour and character with that to diagram 1028.3 in the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") save that the length of the bays shall be as shown in the attached schedule numbered GT50/150/0014-2; and
- directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 24(1) of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113), the authorised marking shall only be used with the sign to diagram 661A in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations; and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised marking may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised marking on the said roads shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised marking and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12 and 31 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised marking in the same manner as they apply to the road marking to diagram 1028.3 in Schedule 6 to those Regulations.



Re-line disabled bay outside 150 Earls Road Portswood, to .5m x 2m, as per map above-






