

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of implementing the Olympic Transport Plan or to facilitate transport services in connection with the London Olympics, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the roads for which the authorities shown on the attached List of Authorities numbered GT50/162/0008-1 are the traffic authority, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") which conforms as to size, colour and character with the traffic sign shown at A on the attached drawing GT50/162/0008-2; save that the direction in which the arrow points may be varied with the arrow pointing horizontally to the left; and
- authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the roads for which the authorities shown on the said List of Authorities are the traffic authority, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") which conforms as to the size colour and character with that shown at B on the said drawing; and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order, Traffic Management Order, or Traffic Regulation Order; and



- 4. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113), the authorised sign may be used with either no road markings, or with any kerbside road marking except those shown in diagrams 1001.3, 1025.1, 1025.3, 1025.4 and 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"), and also may not be used on roads where red route controls apply ("red route controls" being prohibitions or restrictions imposed by or under an order or notice under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on any class of traffic using a GLA road or GLA side road); and
- 5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.
- 6. directs that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the preceding paragraph, the authorised signs A and B shall be retained no later than 31 December 2012



The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A and B in the same manner as they apply to the sign in diagram 650.1 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.


