**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of implementing the Olympic Transport Plan or to facilitate transport services or safe pedestrian facilities in connection with the London Olympics, to a revised list of traffic authorities, hereby:-

1. authorises the placement on roads for which the authorities on the attached list numbered GT50/162/0014-1 are the traffic authority, and at locations that a chief officer of police has given authority for signs to be placed conforming as to size colour and character with those shown referenced "ALL-SK05" and "ALL-SK06" (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised stop signs") in the attached set of drawings numbered GT50/162/0005-2; and
2. authorises the placement on roads for which the authorities on the said list are the traffic authority at appropriate sites of traffic conforming as to size colour and character to signs with those shown referenced "ALL-SK01", "ALL-SK02", "ALL-SK03", "ALL-SK07", "ALL-SK07", "ALL-SK08", "ALL-SK10", "ALL-SK11" and "ALL-SK12" (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised event or check signs") in the said the set of drawings; and
3. directs that the authorised stop signs shall:
 - (a) only be put in place by suitably trained persons, and
 - (b) be used in such a manner that the said signs shall face the direction of the appropriate traffic flow when in use; and



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(c) have a post or other support specifically supplied for the purpose which is of a single colour; and

(d) be signs to which Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 applies; and

4. directs that:

(a) the authorised stop signs, subject to sub-paragraph (d) shall be illuminated by means of retroreflecting material and must be internally lit throughout the hours of darkness; and

(b) the parts of the authorised stop signs coloured yellow shall be fluorescent; and

(c) the parts of the authorised stop signs coloured red may be fluorescent; and

(d) the parts of the authorised stop signs coloured black shall not be illuminated by means of retroreflecting material; and

(e) in paragraph 4 the word "part" in relation to the sign means any part of an authorised stop sign which is uniformly coloured and bounded by parts of a different colour; and

5. directs that the authorised stop signs and those authorised event or check signs referenced "ALL-SK07", "ALL-SK10" and "ALL-SK011" may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order, Traffic Management Order or Traffic Regulation Order; and



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6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised stop signs and the authorised event or check signs, at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised stop signs and the authorised event or check signs, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to those authorised event or check signs referenced "ALL-SK01", "ALL-SK02", "ALL-SK03" and "ALL-SK08" in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 818 in Schedule 4 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to those authorised event or check signs referenced "ALL-SK07" and "ALL-SK10" in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 639 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised event or check sign referenced "ALL-SK11" in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 663 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised event or check sign referenced "ALL-SK12" in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 554.1 Schedule 1 to those Regulations.



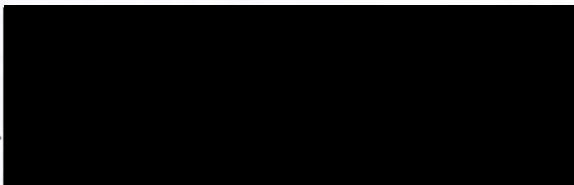
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The provisions of Regulation 12 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised stop signs in the same manner as they apply to the sign to T

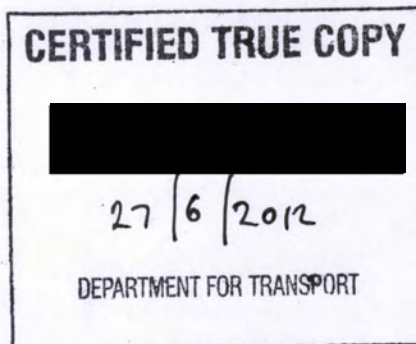
This authorisation replaces the earlier one dated 18 January 2012 under reference GT50/162/0005 which is hereby revoked.

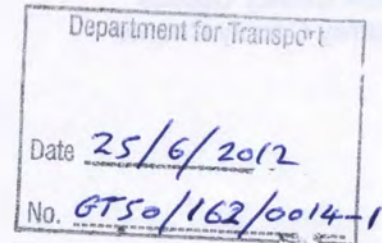
