

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of SI 2002/3113), hereby:-

- directs that, further to the authorisation issued on 7 March 2011
 under reference GT50/154/002, the authorised signs D and E may
 henceforth be erected at any appropriate sites in Exhibition Road,
 Thurloe Place or Thurloe Street within either the Royal Borough of
 Kensington and Chelsea or within the City of Westminster provided
 that the said signs are placed with the authorised road marking (as
 described in paragraph 8 of the said authorisation) or an
 appropriate prescribed road marking; and
- 2. directs that, further to the said authorisation the authorised sign F may henceforth be erected at any appropriate site in Exhibition Road, Cromwell Road or Cromwell Gardens which is subject to Red Route Controls (being defined as prohibitions or restrictions imposed by or under an order or notice under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on any class of traffic using and a GLA road or GLA side road) provided that the said sign is placed with a road marking authorised for the purpose of indicating Red Route Controls.
