

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of indicating match or event day parking controls in the vicinity of Copthall Stadium in the London Borough of Barnet, hereby:-

- authorises the erection within the area shown by the red line (hereinafter called "the Matchday CPZ") on the attached plan numbered GT50/071/0006-1 of traffic signs (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised signs A and B") conforming as to size, colour, and character with those shown at A and B in the attached set of drawings numbered GT50/071/0006-2, save that:
 - a parking permit identifier may be added (including when placed next to references to time of day); and
 - ii) references to a time of day or day of the week may be varied; and
 - iii) the lowest panel with the legend "NEXT EVENT" may varied to show an indication of the date of the next event; and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate C") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at C in the said set of drawings, save that:
 - i) a reference to the time of day may be varied; and
 - a reference to the day of the week may be added; and the lowest panel with the legend "NEXT EVENT" may varied to show an indication of the date of the next event, and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at D in the said set of drawings, save that:



- i) references to the time of day may be varied; and
- ii) references to the day of the week may be added; and
- iii) the lowest panel with the legend "NEXT EVENT" may varied to show an indication of the date of the next event; and
- iv) the parking permit code identifier may be varied; and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of traffic signs (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised signs E and F") conforming as to size, colour, and character with those shown at E and F in the said set of drawings; and
- 5. authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign G") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at G in the said set of drawings; and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plates H, I and J") conforming as to size, colour, and character with those shown at H, I and J in the said set of drawings; and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate K") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at K in the said set of drawings; and
- 8. authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ on the said plan of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate Q") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at Q in the said set of drawings, save that the lowest panel with the legend "NEXT EVENT" may be varied to show an indication of the date of the next event; and
- authorises the erection within the Matchday CPZ of a traffic sign(hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign S ") conforming as to size, colour, and character with that shown at S in the said set of drawings; and



- 10. directs that authorised plates C and Q shall be used with the sign to diagram 663 In Schedule 2 to The Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002 No. 3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
- 11. directs that authorised plates H, I and J may be used with a sign to diagram 639.1B, 660, 660.3, 660.6, 660.7, or 661.1 in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations; and
- 12. directs that authorised plate K may be used with the a sign to diagram 639, 639.1B, 660, 660.3, 660.6, 660.7, or 661.1 in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations; and
- 13. directs that the authorised signs E, F, G, H, I, J, K, Q and S may also have a reference to the time of day or the day of the week varied or added; and
- 14. directs that the authorised signs E, F, G, H, I, J, Q and S may also have a parking permit code identifier varied (including when placed next to references to time of day); and
- 15. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and
- 16. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A, B, D, E, F, G and S, and plates C, H, I, J, K and Q shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A, B, D, E, F, G and S, and plates C, H, I, J, K and Q and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulation 12, 18, and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A, B and S in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 663 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 12 and 20 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plates C, H, I, J, K and Q in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 810 in Schedule 4 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 12, 18, and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs D and E in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 663.2 in Schedule 2 to the 2002 Regulations, as amended by Traffic Signs (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2011 (Part 1 of SI 2011 No. 3041).





Controlled Parking Zone entry plate including event day restrictions.





"Past this point" area entry plate including dates of event.







Event day only limited stay time plate.




SIGN J

Dual use - limited stay and permit holders only time plate.






Event day only waiting restriction time plate.
