



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of places for the recharging of electric motorcycles on roads in the London Borough of Hackney, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on roads for which the London Borough of Hackney is the traffic authority of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown in the attached drawing GT50/80/0017-1, save that
 - i) references to the time limit, time of day, day of the week or the time within which return is prohibited may be varied or omitted; and
 - ii) an arrow may point horizontally to the right or left as appropriate, or be replaced by the legend “opposite”; and
 - iii) the name of the traffic authority, a logo or a symbol may be added; and
 - iv) the requirement to pay at the machine may be omitted (being the legends “Pay at machine”, “Display ticket” and the arrow) and the time of the operation of the bay may be replaced by the legend “At all times”; and
2. directs that the authorised sign shall be used with a road marking to diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002 No. 3113 “the 2002 Regulations”); and
3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and



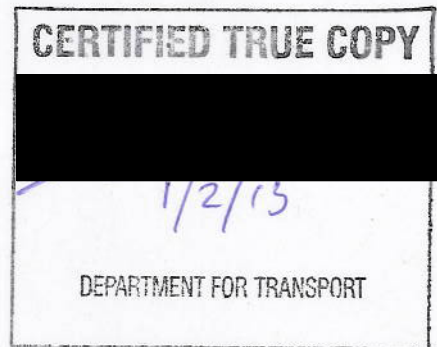
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

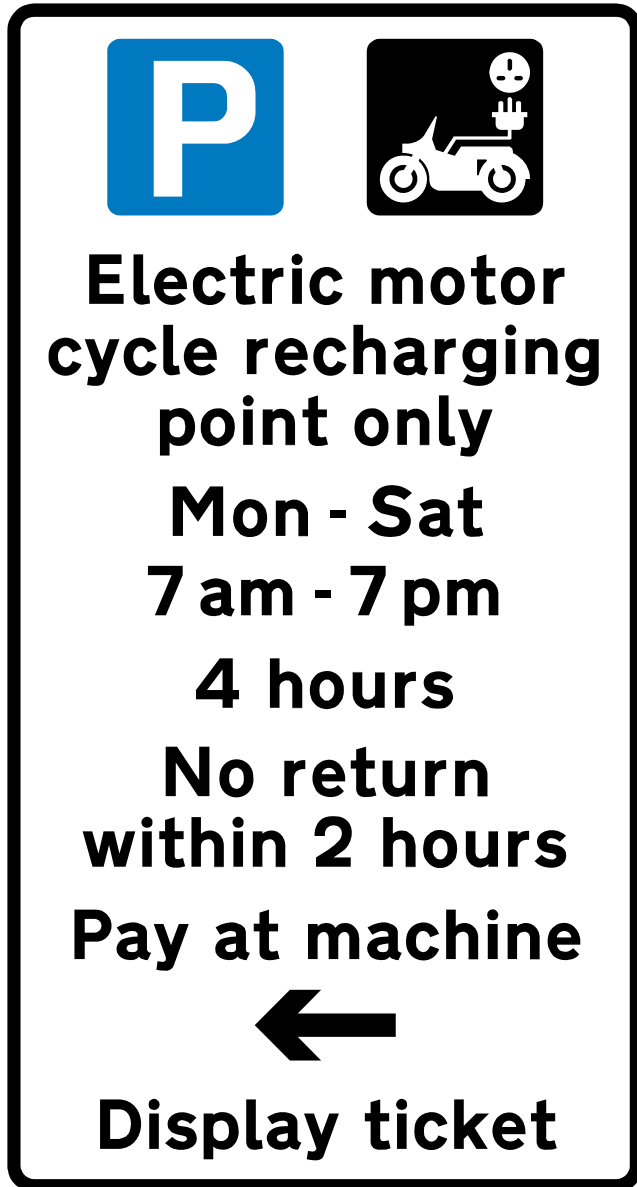
The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 661.1 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
