



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing pedestrians of the direction of traffic at the junction of Commercial Way and Bugsby's Way in the London Borough of Greenwich, hereby:-

1. authorises the placing at or within the vicinity of the site shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/079/0011-1 of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 1029 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"), save that the wording of the authorised marking shall be as shown on the said plan; and
2. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised marking at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

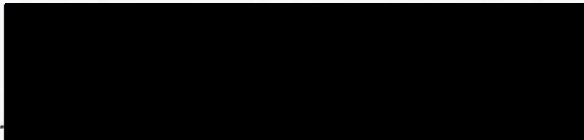
