

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of indicating to drivers a no stopping restriction outside a school in Kelbrook in the county of Lancashire hereby:-

- authorises the erection at the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/064/0029-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/064/0029-2; and
- directs that, the authorised sign shall be used with the road marking shown in diagram 1027.1 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002 No. 3113, "the 2002 Regulations"); and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised sign on the said roads shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 642.2A in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
