

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of the conditions of use of a bus gate in Hythe Station Road, Colchester, Essex, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at the sites shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/045/0023-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered NP 953B; and
- 2. authorises the erection at the said sites on the said plan of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at diagram 953.2 in Schedule 5 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") save that the words "and authorised vehicles" (on three lines) shall replace the word "only"; and
- directs that the authorised sign shall only be placed with the authorised plate;
 and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign and the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised sign and the authorised plate at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 953 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate shown in diagram 953.2 in Schedule 5 to those Regulations.
