



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of requiring traffic to stop for a short period during cycle races, hereby:-

1. authorises the placement on roads for which Wakefield Council is the traffic authority, at those locations that a chief officer of police has given authority for the sign to be placed, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown on the attached drawing numbered NP-SCR; and
2. directs that the authorised sign may be placed only by personnel trained to do so in accordance with the relevant British Cycling protocol; and
3. directs that the authorised sign may be placed only in connection with a cycle race approved under the Cycle Racing on Highways Regulations 1960; and
4. directs that the authorised sign may not be placed on a road subject to a speed limit greater than 60mph; and
5. directs that the post or other support specifically provided for the purpose shall be of any single colour.



6. (i) The authorised sign, subject to sub-paragraph (iii) shall be illuminated by means of retroreflecting material and, must be internally light throughout the hours of darkness.

(ii) (a) the parts of the authorised sign coloured yellow shall be fluorescent;

(b) the parts of the authorised sign coloured red may be fluorescent.

(iii) The parts of the authorised sign coloured black shall not be illuminated by means of retroreflecting material.

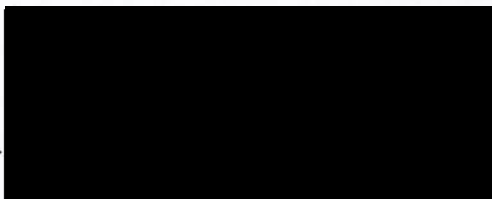
(iv) In this paragraph the word "part" in relation to the authorised sign means any part of the authorised sign which is uniformly coloured and bounded by parts of a different colour.

The provisions of Regulation 12 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (S.I. 2002 No. 3113) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 7031 in Schedule 12 Part I to those Regulations.

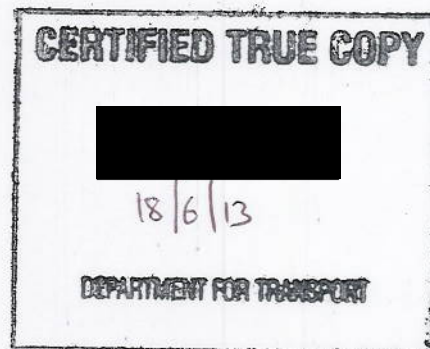
Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 shall apply to the authorised sign.

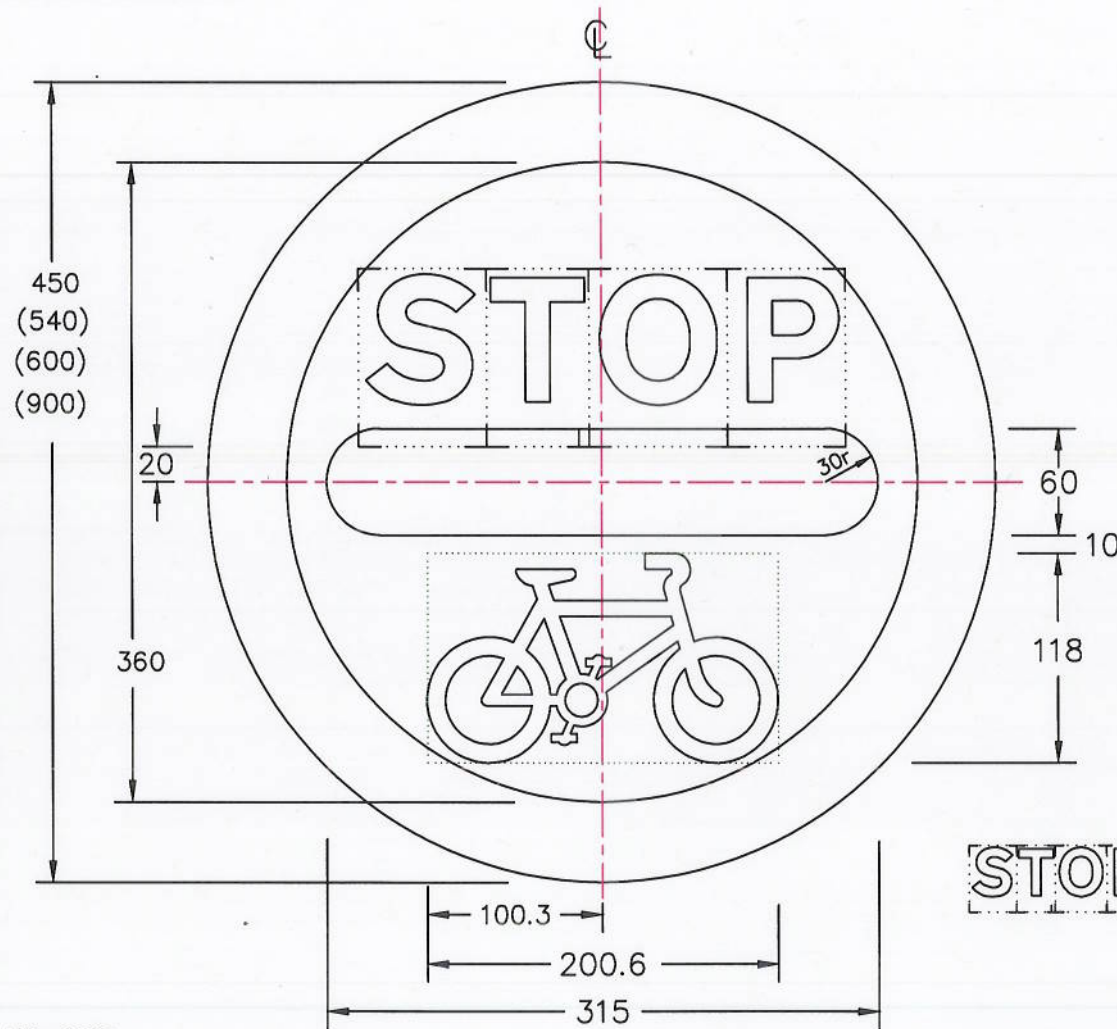
