




**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65
SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having regard to Direction 59 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II to S.I.2002/3113, "the 2002 Directions"), hereby:-

1. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 55(2) of the 2002 Directions, a sign consisting of the light signal shown in diagram 4005 in Schedule 9 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I to S.I.2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") may be used in conjunction with the sign shown in diagram 548.1 in Schedule 1 to the 2002 Regulations at the sites referenced "Proposed Wig Wag Signal Head and Sign to Diag 550.1" on the attached plan numbered GT50/136/0010-1.
