



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing motorists of conditions on roads on which the Tour de France will be taking place, and for which Leeds City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/065/0026-1 save that references to times of day, days of the week or dates may be added; and
2. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
3. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25 of the Traffic Signs General Directions 2002 (Part II of S.I. 2002/3113), the authorised sign may be used with either no road markings, or with any kerbside road marking in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of S.I. 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"), as amended by the Traffic Signs (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2011 (S.I. 2011/3041); and




4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised sign at or near the said site, shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect; and
5. directs that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the preceding paragraph, the authorised sign shall be retained no later than 31 December 2014.

The provisions of Regulation 12, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign in diagram 650.1 in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.

This authorisation replaces the earlier one dated 7 April 2014 under reference GT50/065/0026 which is hereby revoked.
