

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of entry restrictions and giving directions to traffic on roads for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") at, or within 5m of, the site referenced "A" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0035-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced SIGN A shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/006/0035-2; and
- authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") at, or within 5m of, the site referenced "B" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0035-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced SIGN B shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/006/0035-2; and
- directs that references to times of day and days of the week may be varied; and
- 4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign A and B at the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.





The provisions of Regulations 5, 7 and 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362) shall apply to the authorised sign A and B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 2, Item 3 of those Regulations.


