Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of signs/markings for the purpose of informing road users of a mandatory variable speed limit on all purpose trunk roads for which Highways England is the traffic authority.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Section 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf for the purpose of informing road users of a mandatory variable speed limit on all purpose trunk roads for which Highways England is the traffic authority, hereby:

- authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced NP 409 in the attached set of drawings save that (i) the x-height may be varied as indicated and (ii) the legend may include, or a legend may be added for, the name, and logo, of the enforcement authority; and
- 2. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced NP 409.1 in the attached set of drawings save that (i) the x-height may be varied as indicated and (ii) the legend may include, or a legend may be added for, the name, and logo, of the enforcement authority; and
- directs that the numerals indicating the maximum speed limit on the authorised sign B may be varied as appropriate and must conform as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 670 in Schedule 10, Part 2, Item 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- directs that the authorised signs A and B shall only be used as and when required to advise road users of the operation of an approved system of variable speed limit enforcement; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A and B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 880 in Schedule 11, Part 2, Item 64 to those Regulations.

- 2. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced NP 409.1 in the attached set of drawings save that (i) the x-height may be varied as indicated and (ii) the legend may include, or a legend may be added for, the name, and logo, of the enforcement authority; and
- directs that the numerals indicating the maximum speed limit on the authorised sign B may be varied as appropriate and must conform as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 670 in Schedule 10, Part 2, Item 1 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- directs that the authorised signs A and B shall only be used as and when required to advise road users of the operation of an approved system of variable speed limit enforcement; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A and B in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 880 in Schedule 11, Part 2, Item 64 to those Regulations.







Variable speed limit


