Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of signs/markings for the purpose of informing road users of access restrictions on roads for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of access restrictions on roads for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/006/0041-1; save that (a) the permit identifier may be varied or omitted; (b) references to the time period may be varied or omitted; (c) the name of the traffic authority may be added in a panel above the upper panel; and (d) “permit holders” may be varied to “resident permit holders”; and
2. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
3. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month’s notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulations 7 and 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 618.3C described in Schedule 8, Part 2, Item 2 of those Regulations.

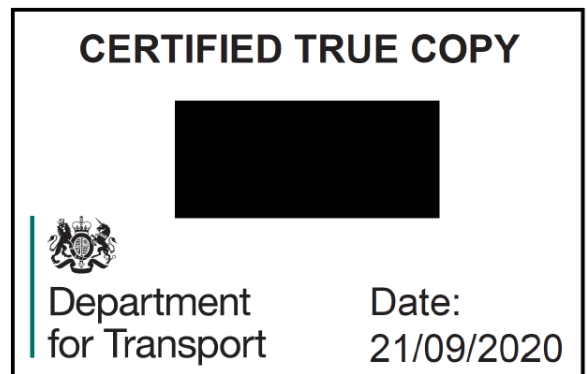


