Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of giving directions to traffic on roads for which Newcastle City Council is the traffic authority.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of giving directions to traffic on roads for which Newcastle City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign A”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref4a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
2. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign B”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref6a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
3. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign C”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref7a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A, B and C at the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A, B and C and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, “the 2016 Regulations”) shall apply to the authorised signs A, B and C in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 2, Item 3 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A, B and C in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 44 to those Regulations.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of giving directions to traffic on roads for which Newcastle City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign A”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref4a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
2. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign B”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref6a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
3. authorises the erection of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign C”) at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/106/0021-1 conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign referenced Ref7a shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0021-2; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A, B and C at the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A, B and C and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

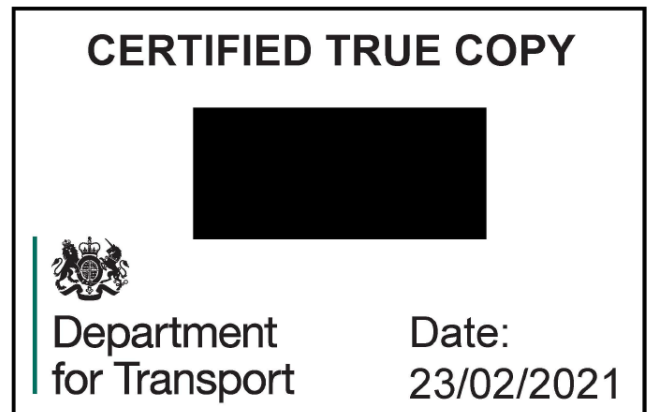
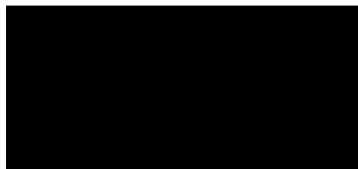

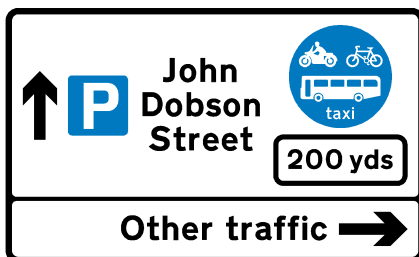
