Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of time-limited drop off/pick up bays on roads in Devon.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of time-limited drop off/pick up bays on roads in Devon, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites, on roads for which Devon County Council is the traffic authority, of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/035/0051-1; save that (a) the time limit specified may be varied as appropriate but shall not be longer than 10 minutes and (b) the x-height may be varied to not less than 15 mm and not more than 40 mm; and
- 2. authorises the placing at the said sites of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 1028.4 (when no legend appears) in Schedule 7, Part 4, Item 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"), save that a continuous longitudinal yellow line 200 millimetres wide shall be placed along the edge of the carriageway in the manner shown in diagram 1028.5 in Schedule 7, Part 4, Item 7 to the 2016 Regulations; and
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign and the authorised marking may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign and the authorised marking at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and the authorised marking and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 7 and 8 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to that shown in Schedule 4, Part 3, Item 2 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 7, 9 and 10 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised marking in the same manner as they apply to the road marking shown in diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 7, Part 4, Item 6 of those Regulations.

4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign and the authorised marking at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and the authorised marking and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.
