# Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

## Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing public rights of way users of the crossing prerequisites in the vicinity of the Broken Cross Level Crossing near Westbury-on-Severn, Gloucester, for which the traffic authority Gloucestershire County Council permits the placing of signs by Network Rail.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf for the purpose of informing public rights of way users of the crossing prerequisites in the vicinity of the Broken Cross Level Crossing near Westbury-on-Severn, Gloucester, for which the traffic authority Gloucestershire County Council permits the placing of signs by Network Rail, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-2; and
- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-3; and
- 3. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-4; and
- 4. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-5; and
- 5. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-8 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign E") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-6; and



- 6. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign F") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-7; and
- 7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A to F at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A to F and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 7 and 11 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 770 shown in Schedule 2, Part 2, Item 51 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs B to F in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in those Regulations.

- 1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-2; and
- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-3; and
- 3. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-4; and
- 4. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-5; and
- 5. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-8 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign E") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-6; and



- 6. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/048/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign F") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/048/0019-7; and
- 7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised signs A to F at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A to F and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 7 and 11 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 770 shown in Schedule 2, Part 2, Item 51 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs B to F in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in those Regulations.

Always telephone before crossing with a vehicle which is large, low, slow moving or with animals







- You must use the telephone provided to get permission to cross
- 2. Follow the instructions given







- Always check green light shows every time you cross
- If no light shows do not cross telephone signaller
- 3. Open both gates on foot
- 4. Check that green light still shows
- Cross with vehicle without stopping
- 6. Check that green light still shows
- 7. Close both gates on foot










ELEVATIONS SCALE: NTS


