Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs, for the purpose of informing road users of requirements for zero emission vehicles on roads for which the London Borough of Camden is the traffic authority.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of requirements for zero emission vehicles on roads for which the London Borough of Camden is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/075/0039-1 save that (i) the time period may be varied; and (ii) the time period may be omitted in which event "except" must be varied to "Except"; and
- directs that the authorised plate shall only be used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613), Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 19 and Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 23 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part I of SI 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- directs the x-height of the authorised plate may be varied to the sizes shown on the said drawing when the authorised plate is used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612) and Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613) of the 2016 Regulations; and
- directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 19 and Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 23 of those Regulations; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order when the authorised plate is used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612) and Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613) of the 2016 Regulations; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plate at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 6, 7 and 8 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Item 15 of those Regulations.

- directs that the authorised plate shall only be used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613), Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 19 and Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 23 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part I of SI 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- directs the x-height of the authorised plate may be varied to the sizes shown on the said drawing when the authorised plate is used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612) and Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613) of the 2016 Regulations; and
- 4. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 19 and Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 23 of those Regulations; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order when the authorised plate is used with the signs shown in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 (diagram 619), Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 7 (diagram 612) and Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 (diagram 613) of the 2016 Regulations; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plate at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 6, 7 and 8 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Item 15 of those Regulations.
