## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Sections 64 and 65

### Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

#### Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs , for the purpose of informing drivers of parking restrictions on roads for which Newcastle City Council is the traffic authority.

The following pages contain a copy of the text from the Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation regarding the above traffic signs.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65**  
**AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing drivers of parking restrictions on roads for which Newcastle City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/106/0022-1; and
2. directs that the following variants may be applied to the authorised sign as appropriate:
  - a) the x-height may be varied to greater than 40 mm;
  - b) a time period may be added in the top panel;
  - c) the name of the traffic authority may be added at the top of the panel;
  - d) the bottom panel may indicate more than one day or date or both;
  - e) the legend in the bottom panel indicating the day and date may be omitted;
  - f) the bottom panel may be omitted;
  - g) the legend in the bottom panel indicating the day and date may be replaced by the legend “Not today” or “NOT TODAY”;
  - h) permit identifiers may be added either to the right of the “P” symbol or proximate to “permit holders”;
  - i) the legend in the top panel may be omitted and replaced with the legend “Permit holders only on event days”;
  - j) the legend “Permit” may be varied to “Resident permit”, and



3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 7 and 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362) shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 5, Part 3, Item 5 of those Regulations.

  - d) the bottom panel may indicate more than one day or date or both;
  - e) the legend in the bottom panel indicating the day and date may be omitted;
  - f) the bottom panel may be omitted;
  - g) the legend in the bottom panel indicating the day and date may be replaced by the legend “Not today” or “NOT TODAY”;
  - h) permit identifiers may be added either to the right of the “P” symbol or proximate to “permit holders”;
  - i) the legend in the top panel may be omitted and replaced with the legend “Permit holders only on event days”;
  - j) the legend “Permit” may be varied to “Resident permit”, and



3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

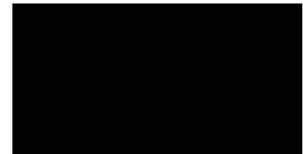

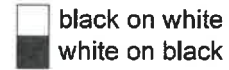
