

## Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Sections 64 and 65

#### Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

#### **Accessible transcript**

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of an exception for vehicles less than 7.5t to a left turn prohibition at the junction of Elkstone Road and Great Western Road in London.

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of an exception for vehicles less than 7.5t to a left turn prohibition at the junction of Elkstone Road and Great Western Road in London, hereby:-

- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/024/0082-1 for which Westminster City Council is the traffic authority of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised plate") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/024/0082-2; and
- directs that the authorised plate shall only be used with the sign to diagram 613 in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") and the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 19 of those Regulations; and
- directs that the provisions of Schedule 3, Parts 1 to 5 of the 2016
   Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the sign described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Paragraph 3 of those Regulations; and
- directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016
   Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate when used on a Schedule
   directional sign, in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in
   Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 45 of those Regulations; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plate at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Paragraph 3 and to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 45 of those Regulations.

- directs that the authorised plate shall only be used with the sign to diagram 613 in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 8 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") and the sign shown in Schedule 12. Part 20, Item 19 of those Regulations; and
- directs that the provisions of Schedule 3, Parts 1 to 5 of the 2016
   Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the sign described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Paragraph 3 of those
   Regulations; and
- 4. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate when used on a Schedule 12 directional sign, in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 45 of those Regulations; and



- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plate may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plate at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plate and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plate in the same manner as they apply to the plate described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Paragraph 3 and to the sign shown in Schedule 12, Part 20, Item 45 of those Regulations.


