# Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

## **Accessible transcript**

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of card and mobile device payment arrangements on the M6 Toll motorway and its slip roads between marker posts MP 17/3 and MP 51/0.

The following pages contain a copy of the text from the Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation regarding the above traffic signs.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of card and mobile device payment arrangements on the M6 Toll motorway and its slip roads between marker posts MP 17/3 and MP 51/0, hereby:

- authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced as "SIGN A" in the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-1 save that the legend in the top panel indicating the distance may be varied to "1 m" or "2 m"; and
- 2. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-2 save that the x-height may be varied; and
- 3. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced as "SIGN E" in the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-3 save that (i) the legend in the top panel indicating the distance may be varied to "½ mile" or "¾ mile" and (ii) the "BREEZE" symbol may be replaced by the "BREEZE" symbol shown on the drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-2; and
- 4. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-4 save that the x-height may be varied; and



- 5. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign E") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-5; and
- 6. authorises at appropriate locations on the said roads, the display of the symbol (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised symbol F") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-6, on variable message signs (VMS) as defined in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- 7. authorises at appropriate locations on the said roads, the display of the symbol (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised symbol G") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-7, on VMS as defined in the 2016 Regulations; and
- 8. directs that the authorised signs A to E and the authorised symbols F and G when displayed on VMS, may be installed on the M6 Toll motorway between the specified marker posts, to indicate amendments to the toll arrangements in compliance with any specific guidance and requirements (including those related to road user safety and accessibility) identified in Traffic Signs Manual (TSM) Chapter 8 or an equivalent, risk assessed, site specific temporary traffic management design and safe method of working derived from any other guidance in TSM Chapter 8; and
- 9. specifies that the dimension lines and character tiles shown on the drawings mentioned in paragraph 1 to 7 above, do not form part of the authorised signs A to E and the authorised symbols F and G;
- 10. specifies, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised signs A to E and display of the authorised symbols F and G on VMS, on the M6 toll motorway and associated slip roads shall continue to have effect only until such



day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A to E and/or the authorised symbols F and G and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A, B, D and E in the same manner as they apply to the sign described in Schedule 13, Part 9, Para. 1(c) of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign C in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in Diagram 7244 in Schedule 13, Part 6, Item 15 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Schedule 13, Parts 5, 6, 9 (paras. 1 to 13) and 12 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised signs A to E in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 13 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Schedule 16 to the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised symbols F and G as they apply to the legends prescribed in Schedule 16 to those Regulations.

- 3. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign C") conforming as to size, colour and character with that referenced as "SIGN E" in the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-3 save that (i) the legend in the top panel indicating the distance may be varied to "½ mile" or "¾ mile" and (ii) the "BREEZE" symbol may be replaced by the "BREEZE" symbol shown on the drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-2; and
- 4. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign D") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-4 save that the x-height may be varied; and



- 5. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign E") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-5; and
- 6. authorises at appropriate locations on the said roads, the display of the symbol (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised symbol F") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-6, on variable message signs (VMS) as defined in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"); and
- 7. authorises at appropriate locations on the said roads, the display of the symbol (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised symbol G") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/188/0007-7, on VMS as defined in the 2016 Regulations; and
