#### Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs

The following pages contain a copy of the text from the Secretary of State to secure the expeditious and safe movement of traffic at the Cutsyke Junction Level Crossing near Cutsyke, for which the traffic authority Wakefield City Council permits the placing of signs by Network Rail.

# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, to secure the expeditious and safe movement of traffic at the Cutsyke Junction Level Crossing near Cutsyke, for which the traffic authority Wakefield City Council permits the placing of signs by Network Rail, hereby:-

- authorises the placing at or within the vicinity of the site shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/179/0009-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 1045 in Schedule 9, Part 6, Item 26 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of SI 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations"), save that the overall size and shape of the authorised marking shall be as shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/179/0009-2; and
- 2. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised marking at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised marking and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 shall apply to the authorised marking as it applies to the marking shown in diagram 1045 in Schedule 9, Part 6, Item 26 to the 2016 Regulations.



GT50/179/0009

The provisions of Regulations 7 and 9 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised marking in the same manner as they apply to the marking shown in diagram 1045 in Schedule 9, Part 6, Item 26 of those Regulations.






Figure 1 – Location Plan:





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
