Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs, for the purpose of informing road users of waiting restrictions in Sheen Lane, London, for which the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames is the traffic authority.

- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/093/0019-1 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/093/0019-2; and
- directs that the authorised sign shall only be used with the road marking to diagram 1025.1 in Schedule 7, Part 4, Item 9 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations");
- directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
- 4. directs that, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to that shown in Schedule 4, Part 3, Item 2 of the 2016 Regulations.




