Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of entry requirements on roads for which Oxfordshire County Council is the traffic authority.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of entry requirements on roads for which Oxfordshire County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate A”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-2; and
2. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate B”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-3; and
3. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate C”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-4; and
4. directs that the authorised plates A, B and C shall be used with the sign to diagram 619 in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2012/362, “the 2016 Regulations”); and
5. directs that the provisions of Schedule 3, Parts 1 to 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plates A, B and C in the same manner as they apply to the sign described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Item 15 of those Regulations; and



6. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plates A, B and C may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plates A, B and C at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plates A, B and C and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plates A, B and C in the same manner as they apply to the plate described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Item 15 of those Regulations.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of entry requirements on roads for which Oxfordshire County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate A”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-2; and
2. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate B”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-3; and
3. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/120/0039-1 of a traffic sign consisting of a plate (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised plate C”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/120/0039-4; and
4. directs that the authorised plates A, B and C shall be used with the sign to diagram 619 in Schedule 3, Part 2, Item 12 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2012/362, “the 2016 Regulations”); and
5. directs that the provisions of Schedule 3, Parts 1 to 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised plates A, B and C in the same manner as they apply to the sign described in Schedule 3, Part 3, Item 15 of those Regulations; and

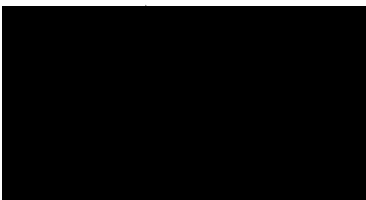


6. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised plates A, B and C may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and
7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised plates A, B and C at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised plates A, B and C and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

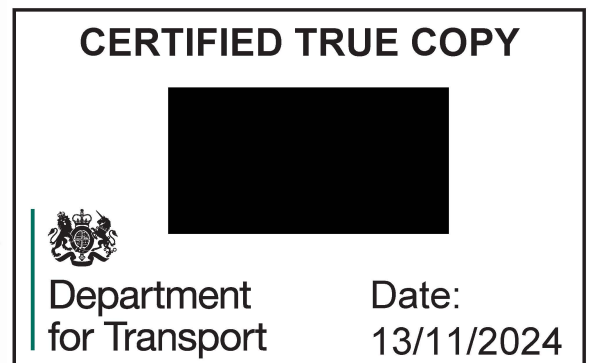

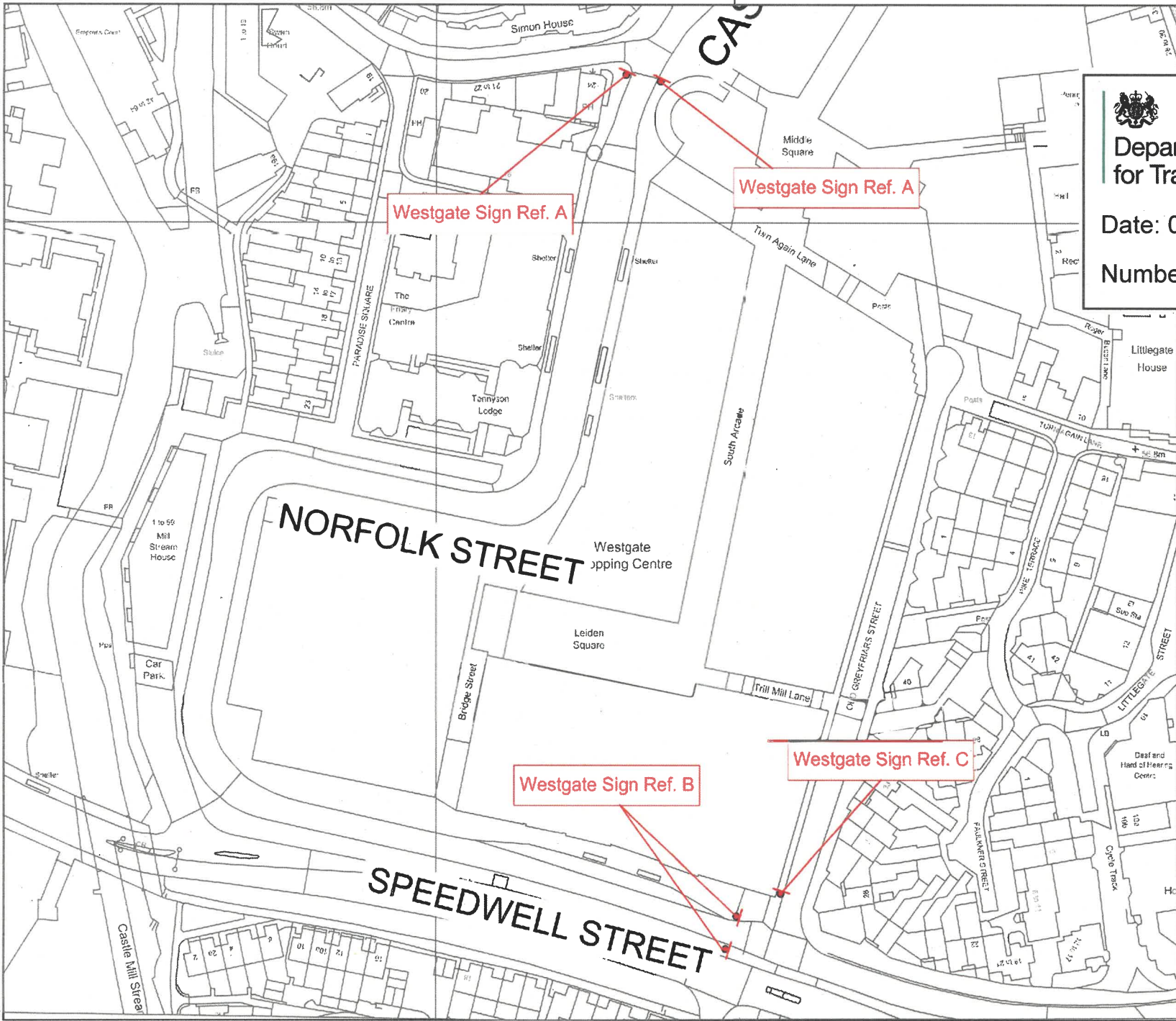
