Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs, for the purpose of reducing vehicle speeds in West Works Way, Longbridge for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 AUTHORISATION OF ROAD HUMPS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of reducing vehicle speeds in West Works Way, Longbridge for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the placing upon a road hump, at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically and marked as "A" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-1 of a parallel crossing (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised crossing A") as defined within Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") and conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-2, and
- 2. authorises the placing upon a road hump, at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically and marked as "B" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-1 of a parallel crossing (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised crossing B") as defined within Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations and conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-3, and
- 3. directs that the provisions of Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53, Columns 4 and 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised crossings A and B; and
- 4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised crossings A and B at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised



hump, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 shall apply to the road hump and the authorised crossings A and B, save that an imaginary line along the centre of each hump from one side of the road to the other need not be in the same position as an imaginary line along the centre of the limits of the crossing from one side of the road to the other as shown in the diagram in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53 of the 2016 Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 9, 10 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised crossings A and B in the same manner as they apply to the marking shown in the diagram in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53 of those Regulations.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 90 AUTHORISATION OF ROAD HUMPS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of reducing vehicle speeds in West Works Way, Longbridge for which Birmingham City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

- 1. authorises the placing upon a road hump, at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically and marked as "A" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-1 of a parallel crossing (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised crossing A") as defined within Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") and conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-2, and
- 2. authorises the placing upon a road hump, at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically and marked as "B" on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-1 of a parallel crossing (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised crossing B") as defined within Schedule 1 of the 2016 Regulations and conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached plan numbered GT50/006/0050-3, and
- 3. directs that the provisions of Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53, Columns 4 and 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised crossings A and B; and
- 4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised crossings A and B at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised



hump, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 shall apply to the road hump and the authorised crossings A and B, save that an imaginary line along the centre of each hump from one side of the road to the other need not be in the same position as an imaginary line along the centre of the limits of the crossing from one side of the road to the other as shown in the diagram in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53 of the 2016 Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 9, 10 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised crossings A and B in the same manner as they apply to the marking shown in the diagram in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 53 of those Regulations.



- 8. Sign post and foundation details in accordance with BCC drawing HW12.01. See drawing 20327-RLL-21-00-DR-C-2028 for additional foundation
- 9. All traffic sign posts shall be painted black with ta reflective yellow visibility band, unless otherwise stated. The surface treatment will be as specified in the appendices of the BCC Specification for highway works.
- 10. Proposed traffic signs to be constructed in accordance with BCC standard details in HW series 12, 13 & 14.
- 11. All road markings are to be laid in accordance with Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD) 2016. Unless specified all white markings are reflectorized by incorporation into the road marking material and to the wet surface of the marking of either solid class beads in accordance with BS EN 1423 and BS EN 1424 or other suitably qualified material.
- 12. Road marking annotation in key as follows: Diag. No. / Gap / Length / Width (e.g. 1004/4000/2000/100).
- 13. Tiger Crossing layout designed in accordance with Figure 17-1 Diagram 1001.5 in Traffic Signs Manual, Chapter 6 - Traffic Control.
- 14. This drawing should be read in conjunction with the Traffic Signs & Road Markings Drawings: 20327-RLL-21-00-DR-C-2027 & 2028
- 15. Ducts laid in accordance with BCC HCD HW 5.09 Duct Trench Cross Section.
- 16. Tactile Paving layout in accordance with BCC HCD HW 12.53 Tactile Paving Setting Out Arragements.
