### Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

#### Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of giving directions to road users on Temple Way, Bristol, and where Bristol City Council is the traffic authority.

- authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the site shown schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/015/0031-1 of traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with the sign shown in the attached drawing numbered GT50/015/0031-2; and
- 2. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs, legends, arrows and lane marking symbols shown in Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of those Regulations; and
- 3. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said site shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.




