Authorisation of traffic signs and special directions

Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of giving directions to road users in Dover, on roads for which Kent County Council is the traffic authority.

The following pages contain a copy of the text from the Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation regarding the above traffic signs.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of giving directions to road users in Dover, on roads for which Kent County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the direction sign”) consisting of a legend or symbol, or a combination of both, provided for in Schedule 12 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, “the 2016 Regulations”), save that
 - i. the symbol (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised symbol A”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0033-1 may be placed on the direction sign;
 - ii. save that the symbol (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised symbol B”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0033-2 may be placed on the direction sign; and
2. directs that any of the following legends (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised legends”) may be placed on the direction sign:
 - i. EES BORDER CHECKS
 - ii. UK & Non EU Passports
 - iii. EU Passports
 - iv. Western Docks
 - v. Eastern Docks
 - vi. Follow



3. directs that the x-height of the authorised legends may be 80% of the x-height used for the direction sign; and
4. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised symbols A and B and the authorised legends may only be placed on a direction sign to Schedule 12, Part 2 in the 2016 Regulations; with appropriate background Diagram A plate: item number 1 to 4, 7, 8, 9 or Diagram B plate: item number 1 to 4, 7, 8, 9; and
5. directs that the authorised symbols A and B must have a white border when placed on a blue, dark green or black background direction sign to Schedule 12, Part 2 in the 2016 Regulations; and
6. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the direction sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 12, Part 2 of those Regulations; and
7. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised symbols A and B in the same manner as they apply to the symbol shown in Schedule 12, Part 11, Item 21 of those Regulations; and
8. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised legends in the same manner as they apply to the legends shown in Schedule 12, Part 3 of those Regulations; and
9. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the inclusion of the authorised symbols A and B, and the authorised legends, on the direction sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the direction sign, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the direction sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 12, Part 2 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised symbols A and B in the same manner as they apply to the symbols shown in Schedule 12, Part 11 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised legends in the same manner as they apply to the legends shown in Schedule 12, Part 3 of those Regulations.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of giving directions to road users in Dover, on roads for which Kent County Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the direction sign”) consisting of a legend or symbol, or a combination of both, provided for in Schedule 12 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, “the 2016 Regulations”), save that
 - i. the symbol (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised symbol A”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0033-1 may be placed on the direction sign;
 - ii. save that the symbol (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised symbol B”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/060/0033-2 may be placed on the direction sign; and
2. directs that any of the following legends (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised legends”) may be placed on the direction sign:
 - i. EES BORDER CHECKS
 - ii. UK & Non EU Passports
 - iii. EU Passports
 - iv. Western Docks
 - v. Eastern Docks
 - vi. Follow



3. directs that the x-height of the authorised legends may be 80% of the x-height used for the direction sign; and
4. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised symbols A and B and the authorised legends may only be placed on a direction sign to Schedule 12, Part 2 in the 2016 Regulations; with appropriate background Diagram A plate: item number 1 to 4, 7, 8, 9 or Diagram B plate: item number 1 to 4, 7, 8, 9; and
5. directs that the authorised symbols A and B must have a white border when placed on a blue, dark green or black background direction sign to Schedule 12, Part 2 in the 2016 Regulations; and
6. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the direction sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 12, Part 2 of those Regulations; and
7. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised symbols A and B in the same manner as they apply to the symbol shown in Schedule 12, Part 11, Item 21 of those Regulations; and
8. directs that the provisions of Schedule 12, Parts 1 to 29 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised legends in the same manner as they apply to the legends shown in Schedule 12, Part 3 of those Regulations; and
9. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the inclusion of the authorised symbols A and B, and the authorised legends, on the direction sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the direction sign, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.
