Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of signs/markings for the purpose of indicating to traffic the presence of a Zebra crossing in Webb's Road near the junction with Honeywell Road in London.

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of indicating to traffic the presence of a Zebra crossing in Webb's Road near the junction with Honeywell Road in London hereby:-

- 1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/098/0016-1 for which London Borough of Wandsworth is the traffic authority, of a yellow or fluorescent yellow globe (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised globe") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown at diagram 4007 in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 27 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, "the 2016 Regulations") save that the authorised globe may display a steady light; and
- directs that the authorised globe may only be placed at the said sites if the authorised globe and the associated apparatus used in connection with it meets the requirements of Schedule 14, Part 4, Paragraph 13 of the 2016 Regulations; and
- 3. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised globe at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised globe and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulation 7 and Schedule 14, Part 4, Paragraph 13 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised globe in the same manner as they apply to the signal to diagram 4007 in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 27 of those Regulations.


