Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of access restrictions on roads for which Milton Keynes City Council is the traffic authority.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of access restrictions on roads for which Milton Keynes City Council is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT50/103/0016-1; save that
 - i. the bottom panel may be omitted;
 - ii. the permit identifier may be varied or omitted;
 - iii. additional permit identifiers may be included;
 - iv. the legend “permit holders and” and the permit identifier may be omitted;
 - v. the legend “and authorised vehicles” may be omitted;
 - vi. the disabled badge holder symbol may be added, and the legend “and” added as appropriate;
2. directs that the authorised sign must be used with flashing lamps of the same size, colour and type as that shown in diagram 4004 in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 23 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, “the 2016 Regulations”); and
3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 618.3C shown in Schedule 8, Part 2, Item 2 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Schedule 8, Parts 1 and 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 618.3C shown in Schedule 8, Part 2, Item 2 of those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulation 7 and Schedule 14, Parts 1 to 6 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the flashing lamps in the same manner as they apply to diagram 4004 in Schedule 14, Part 2, Item 23 of those Regulations.

3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and

4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

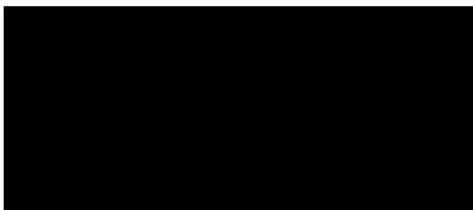

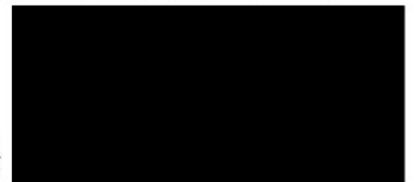

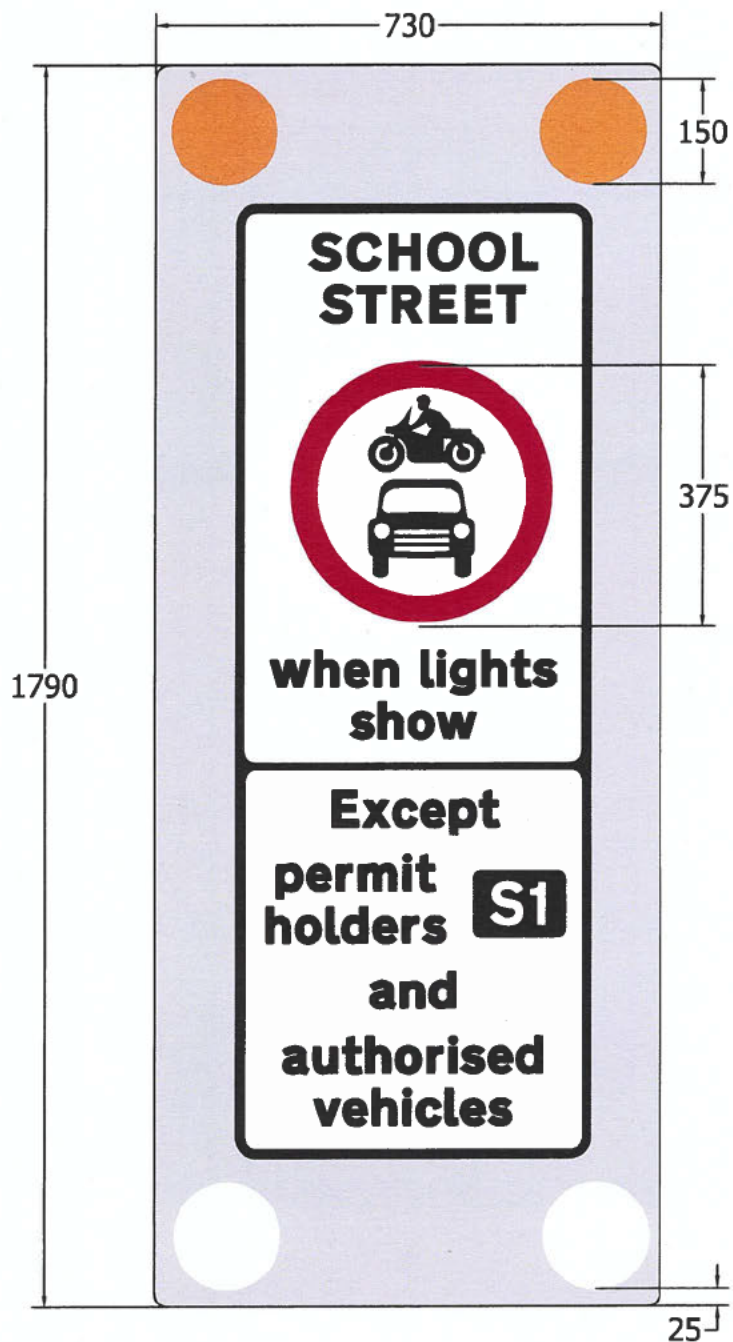
